Dear Parents/Carers of children at **Moor Lane**

Below you will find details of start and end of the day in light of our review of the past few days since coming back to school. Start times are for when lessons start so your child needs to be in school and in their class by that time. Please be mindful when parking at either site that you are not blocking gate ways or parking illegally, thank you (especially at the rear of Moor Lane)

Breakfast Club

From 7:30 - 8:15 one adult to bring their child down to the front door if children do not walk themselves.

From 8:15 the gate will be closed, so buzz if your child needs to come in the end of breakfast club. Charges for breakfast club are £1 from 7:30 – 8:30 or any part of this time.

Start of Day

Year 6 need to be in class by 8:30. Gates will be opened by staff from 8:20 and children will walk in to school on their own.

Year 5 need to be in class by 8:45. Gates will be opened by staff from 8:35 and children will walk in to school on their own.

Year 4 need to be in class by 9am. Gates will be opened by staff from 8:50 and children will walk in to school on their own.

Year 3 need to be in class by 9:15. Gates will be opened by staff from 9:05 and children will walk in to school on their own.

End of Day

At 2:30 the gates will be opened for year 6 to leave the site or wait for parents/carers. One adult per household can come on to the yard and stand socially distanced to collect their child from the yard.

At 2:45 the gates will be opened for year 5 to leave the site or wait for parents/carers. One adult per household can come on to the yard and stand socially distanced to collect their child from the yard.

At 3pm the gates will be opened for year 4 children to leave the site or wait for parents/carers. One adult per household can come on to the yard and stand socially distanced to collect their child from the pupil entrance.

At 3:15 the gates will be opened for year 3 parents/carers. One adult per household can come on to the yard and stand socially distanced to collect their child from the main entrance.

Please bring siblings in for the earlier drop off and leave children until the later collection time.
