Health and Safety

The roof at Moor Lane is due to be completely replaced with work starting tomorrow or Thursday and lasting until the end of February 2021. The plan is for part of the yard to become the staff car park and the rear staff entrance to be used at the compound for the works. There have been extensive meetings to plan for this but I ask you all to be especially vigilant when entering or leaving the Moor Lane site. The new "car park" will be completely fenced off and the gates will be safe to use as they are now. Scaffolding will be right around the building but no impact is expected on the inside of the school.
