Use Bug Club each day to read a book that has been allocated to your child. Logins for Bug Club are available from school.

<p>Practise writing your full name twice a day! Every morning Reception will be writing their names to vote for different things in the day and writing in their books and writing their names next to models or creations they would like to keep and not tidy up. So lots of practise is needed for our activities in school.</p>	<p>In phonics we have learnt new letter sounds. Can you remember any of them? Write them down and see if you can draw a picture of something that starts with that letter.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">S</p> 	<p>Can you go on a number hunt in your house? Find the number 1 on something then the number 2 on something else. Keep finding new things around your house with the numbers from 1 to 10 on them.</p>  
<p>Can you write the numbers you know in order? Make sure your numbers are written correctly!</p> <p style="text-align: center;">0 1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9 10</p>	<p>Go on a shape hunt around your house. Can you find anything that looks like these 2D shapes?</p> 	<p>Use YouTube to find 'cosmic kids yoga'. Take part in one of the yoga sessions. Remember to start your session with "Namaste"!</p>
<p>Mrs Lombard has been teaching the Reception children some French greetings. Can you remember any? Teach your family some French words and greetings and see if they can teach you any new ones!</p> 	<p>Use a search engine like 'swiggle' or 'google' to research an animal that starts with the same letter as your name. How many legs does it have? Is it a big animal or a small one? Can you draw a picture of the animal and write its name next to it.</p>	<p>We have been reading the book called Elmer. It's a story about an elephant called Elmer who is patchwork coloured. We have talked about how important and special it is to be different. Can you make your own Elmer the elephant that is different to this elephant? Make it unique to you!</p> 
<p>At the end of October it will be Hallowe'en. Can you make a scared Hallowe'en mask? Draw a picture of the mask you want to make first and the make it using card and some string or elastic bands.</p> 	<p>Junk Modelling – Draw a picture of something that you would like to build with recycling. Go on a hunt for used boxes, tubes, pots (etc) for your model. Can you make an amazing model with them?</p>	<p>Here is a piece of art by the artist 'Mondrian'. Can you recreate this artwork at home? Use anything you like.</p>
