### **Anti-Bullying Week**

Next week is Anti-Bullying week and to launch this very important week children are invited to come to school wearing odd socks to symbolize that difference is a good thing. This is not a fund raising event this is simply a launch of the learning we will be doing next week. In preparation for Anti-Bullying week, many children across school have helped me to review our Anti-Bullying policy, which can be found on our school website.

### **After School Provision**

Due to changes in staffing, we will no longer be able to hold teatime club at Moor Lane on Tuesday nights. If your child needs to stay at school after 4pm on Tuesdays and goes to the Moor Lane site they will be walked to Church Street (Infant Site) straight after school and spend the whole of their teatime at Church Street and need to be picked up from there. If children are attending after school clubs until 4pm these will still run until 26<sup>th</sup> November. If children go to teatime til 4pm at Moor Lane, they can join these clubs or come to Church Street until 4pm. At least two members of staff will walk the children to Church Street – they will not be allowed to walk down on their own. After the 26<sup>th</sup> November, there will no longer be after school provision on Tuesdays (but children can attend the Church Street club). Apologies for any inconvenience we are trying to retain after school provision as much as possible.

### **Health & Safety**

Please make sure children actually enter the buildings or are welcomed by staff at the start of the school day. Please do not drive off and presume we know your child is on the premises.

### **Healthy Teeth**

Over the next few weeks, the children will be learning about oral health. On Monday, your child will be given an information booklet and competition entry form about dental hygiene. Please return these to school as soon as possible. The booklet includes instructions and covering letter.

Please remember next Friday is Children In Need day and children can come in to school in non-uniform. All donations gratefully accepted.
