Play Scheme

We will be running our Summer Play Scheme during the holidays. The scheme will take place in the first week of the holidays from **Monday 25th July until Friday 29th July** (we do not break up for the summer term until Thursday 21st July) The Play Scheme will run from 9am – 12 noon. As previously there will be a small charge, this year this will be £2.00 per day per child, this is to cover snacks and activities during the week.

The Play Scheme will be led by school staff and we will be using the usual school procedures for supervision, collection and first aid - all staff are first aiders. Any injuries will be dealt with by us and forms/ bump notes will be provided as usual. Please ensure we have full contact details for you while your child is at the Play Scheme.

Our usual Children's Rights approach will apply and the usual routines should be followed – no lipslip or medicines unless they are handed to myself or Miss Threadkell. Children will not be allowed to use any outdoor play equipment if they are wearing ear rings.

All children should wear suitable clothes - sensible footwear, sun hats. Children may bring water bottles although drinks will be available during each session. Aprons will be available for some of these activities- but inevitably children get messy, so please send children in clothes they can get dirty!

We want the Play Scheme to be fun but we do expect good behaviour - from everyone! We will open the door at 8.50am each day and children will be registered for health and safety reasons. Children can be collected at 12.00 – please inform us if anyone other than you is going to collect your child - we will NOT allow children to go with other people unless we have been notified.

If you would like your child to come to the Play Scheme, please complete form and return to school as soon as possible. Payment for the Summer Play Scheme can be made via ParentPay for any children who attend our school.

School Meals

From the start of the new term in September 2022, our school meals will be provided by a new company called Chartwells, there will be no change to our catering staff within school. There will be new menus which will be available on the school website later this term or paper copies can be requested from the school office. As a result in this change parents will need to complete a new Medical Diet Request Form and return it to school by the end of this term. There is also a Medical Evidence Support Form, to be completed if you do not have any medical evidence which can be completed in lieu of this. These forms will be sent home with children who currently have special diet requests.
