### **Rights Respecting School Re-accreditation**

I am very pleased to inform you that we have achieved Rights Respecting Gold Award again!

Strengths of the school include:

- Happy, confident children who clearly know that they have rights and are committed to helping to realise these for other children locally and globally.
- Highly effective leadership of the rights related work at all levels, including from young people.
- Consistent messaging about rights and respect underpinning every dimension of the school's work.
- The language of rights is evident in all activities - in the classroom, the wider school and in conversations with parents and governors.
- Strong pupil participation. There are several different mechanisms for children to feed into decision making and leadership in different areas of school life. Children felt listened to, that their views matter and that they could make a positive difference.
